

Selection Criteria – ECEI Coordinator

Essential:

1. Tertiary qualifications and working experience in early childhood education or allied health industry and AHPRA, registration or equivalent professional body.
2. Demonstrated experience in facilitating child development assessments and writing reports
3. Demonstrated experience in providing group and individual interventions for children with disability or developmental delay using a family centred strengths based approach
4. Excellent written and oral communication, interpersonal and negotiation skills, with the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships
5. Demonstrated well-developed organisational, time management and administrative skills with the ability to plan, prioritise and meet deadlines
6. Strong computer literacy skills with the capacity to work with various participant management data portals to create and maintain participant records
7. Demonstrated understanding of the National Disability Insurance Scheme, the ECEI approach and commitment to early childhood intervention best practice principals

Desirable:

1. Hanen training and certification
2. Lived experience of disability
3. Networks within Culturally and Linguistically Diverse communities and/or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities
