

Selection Criteria – Program Manager ECEI

Essential:

1. Tertiary qualifications and working experience in early childhood education or allied health industry and AHPRA registration or equivalent professional body
2. Operation leadership experience within an early childhood intervention or paediatric focused setting
3. Demonstrated experience and independence in facilitating child development assessments, preparing reports and providing group and individual interventions for children with disability or developmental delay through family centred and capacity building approaches
4. Demonstrated understanding of the National Disability Insurance Scheme, the ECEI approach and best practice guidelines
5. Excellent written and oral communication, interpersonal and negotiation skills, with the ability to communicate sensitively and effectively with all people to establish and maintain effective relationships
6. Strong computer literacy skills with the capacity to work with various participant management data portals to create and maintain participant records
7. Strong knowledge of regional and local services, supports and resources

Desirable:

1. Lived experience of disability
2. Networks within Culturally and Linguistically Diverse communities and/or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities
