

Selection Criteria

ECEI Coordinator - General

Essential:

1. Tertiary qualification/certification or relevant experience in the area of allied health, family/disability support or early childhood education
2. Sound knowledge of child development and experience working with children and families with a family centred, strengths based approach
3. Ability to support families and carers to identify their child's strengths and needs and articulate functional, measurable, participation based goals for the future
4. Excellent written & oral communication, interpersonal and negotiation skills, with the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships
5. Well-developed organisational, time management, administrative skills and computer literacy with the ability to plan, prioritise and meet deadlines
6. Working knowledge of regional mainstream and community supports and services for children
7. Demonstrated awareness of the National Disability Insurance Scheme, the ECEI approach and commitment to early childhood intervention best practice principals

Desirable:

1. Lived experience of disability
2. Networks within Culturally and Linguistically Diverse communities and/or Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities
3. Early Childhood Education/Intervention Experience
