

Selection Criteria – Child, Youth and Family Worker

Essential:

1. Demonstrated experience providing support to children, youth and families whilst incorporating self-directed planning
2. Ability to effectively deliver programs within a group work context
3. High level of interpersonal and organisational skills and the ability to use initiative
4. Relevant tertiary qualification (social work, psychology or Allied Health) or substantial progress towards one
5. Demonstrated knowledge, empathy and understanding of issues relating to people with mental illness and how mental illness impacts on children, young people and their families
6. Knowledge of child and adolescent development

Desirable:

1. Direct experience in providing child and mental health services
2. Experience working with Client Management Software
3. Experience working with people from Indigenous and Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds
4. Experience working with people that identify as either gay, lesbian, bisexual, transgender or intersex
5. Approved group facilitator in programs of relevance that support children and young people
6. Familiar with Intereach programs and activities and other relevant local and regional services
