

Selection Criteria – Community Linker (Level 3)

Essential:

- Demonstrated ability to communicate and work effectively with a diverse range of people from various cultural and socio-economic backgrounds and of varying abilities
- Ability to effectively engage, assess, support and appropriately refer individuals to relevant services
- Capacity to build and maintain strong working relationships with key stakeholders, to build and participate in effective partnerships for the benefit of community, individuals, programs and organisation
- Experience working in the community or human services field or similar with strong coordination skills
- Well-developed oral, written and interpersonal communication skills
- Well-developed organisational and time management skills
- Strong networking skills
- Computer literacy: Basic – intermediate skills in Microsoft Office
- Solid understanding and working knowledge of community development principles and practice
- Knowledge and understanding of an extensive range of local and regional organisations and programs that support community and individual well-being

Desirable:

- Knowledge and understanding of the issues relating to the needs of the nominated priority groups relevant to the position including socially & financially disadvantaged members of the community
- Community involvement
- Experience working with people from Indigenous and Culturally and Linguistically Diverse backgrounds
- Relevant tertiary qualifications (or working towards) and/or relevant experience in a community support/development role
