### ► Who can access Community Links?

There is no assessment process or criteria to access support through Community Links. Community Links is for any community member, any age, including people who identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander, Culturally and Linguistically Diverse, and/or LGBTIQ+

Community Links can also support people with disability, or people with mental health conditions who are not receiving funding through the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) and who may require support to link to their local community or apply for NDIS support.

Community and mainstream organisations can contact Community Links for information and support on Intereach services, as well as support to create accessible and inclusive environments.
