Do you want to make a real difference in the lives of older Australians?
We are looking for volunteers for home visits to provide companionship and friendship to older people in your community. This is a great opportunity to join the Intereach team, we would love to have you on board.

How does it work?

The Aged Care Volunteer Visitors Scheme (ACVVS) is a free service to support volunteer visitors in providing friendship and companionship to lonely or isolated older people.

There are a range of reasons people can feel isolated.

- Isolated from culture and heritage
- little contact with friends or relatives
- mobility challenges
- being different in some way.

Regular visits from volunteers can help to improve quality of life for those most vulnerable in our communities.

Intereach is proud to be one of 140 community organisations funded by the Australian Government to deliver this special and important service.

Your commitment:

A minimum of 20 visits a year are required of you (one hour a fortnight).
